The Walsh Family Village is part of a lodging project located on the Avera McKennan medical campus in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. The mission of the project is to provide housing and assistance for families and patients that travel from outlying areas to receive treatment at Avera McKennan Hospital, and who are not able to afford traditional housing options. The three-building village was funded entirely by donations, and includes facilities for adult and pediatric patients and their families, guests with special needs, and community space for play, meditation and other activities.

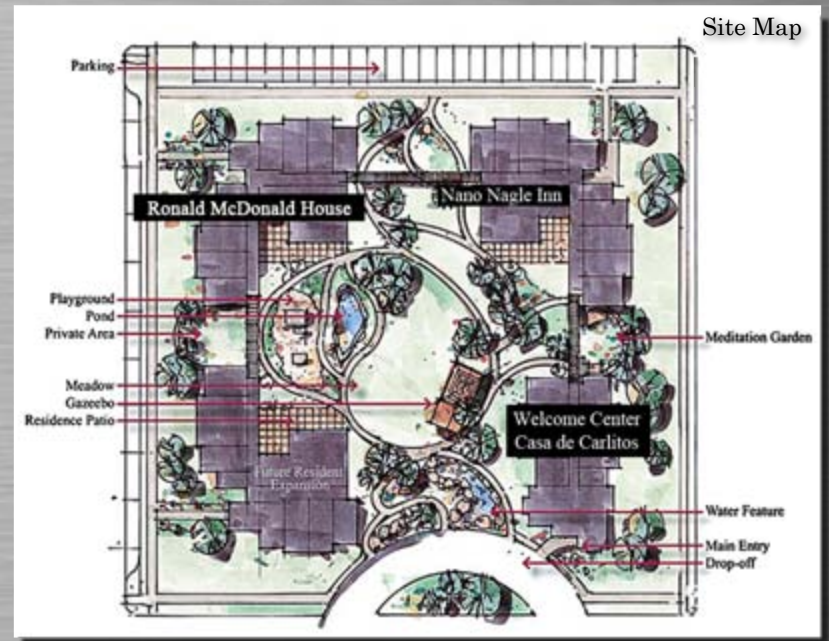
